Dear Commissioners and Staff:



We would like to respond to the counts 1-4.

Count One:

Why did we incur a 10 year, short-term debt from Steve and Janet Adams?

To keep this utility company running, and to provide the best service available to our metered customers. This note paid off the original note to the McClains in which we were all responsible for including: Bellemont Water Company, Elliott Ness and Klaudia Ness. (The ACC was aware of the original note, and never responded when The Ness Family took over). When refinancing our stock in BWC, we did not know that we were in violation of the any laws under the ACC. In addition to this, our CPA, Rodney Wilson was aware of this transaction and never questioned or responded to this matter.

At this time, we have a sale pending if ACC will grant permission to us in order to sell our stock. This will clear the debt to Steve and Janet Adams, and release the lien on BWC.

Count Two:

There was a lawsuit against BWC and The Ness Family from the McClains for non-payment. The 10 year, short-term note was simply taking the McClains position for the Ness's stock.

Count Three:

Again in our ignorance of the ACC laws, Klaudia Ness never provided us with any written information concerning the standpipe revenues, or any other orders from the ACC.

She simply refused to inform us. She said, "she would supply us with information on a need to know basis".

As of July 2010-November 2010, I, Brad Ness, felt it necessary to take over the standpipe because the funds were being misused. I was also very concerned that from 10-2009 through 5-2010, that there was only \$60.00 deposited. (The ACC had copies of these bank statements and didn't seem to be concerned at all)

I, also felt I had to respond to the lawsuit against BWC to protect the interest of the company.

I never once used any funds for personal use. As far as I'm concerned it was for BWC.

At this time, regarding the standpipe revenues, I, or Erik Ness believe that we do not owe any monies from the standpipe as all monies went back into BWC, in order to save the company.

Count Four:

Klaudia Ness and Rodney Wilson, CPA were responsible for this report.

IN CONCLUSION:

This company has drained us mentally, emotionally, physically, and financially. The circumstances regarding this company has caused many hardships, marriage problems, a loss of a home, and on-going family feuds. Financially, we have never made any MONIES. We have drained our savings. We have refinanced other assets of ours with all monies going to BWC. We have paid labor out of our own personal account all for BWC. All we have done is put hard labor into this company. We have pulled pumps many times in the middle of winter (in Flagstaff). We have worked on electrical issues for days at a time. We have fixed broken pipes. We have plowed snow. We have brought in gravel. This list doesn't end.

In conclusion, we ask that the ACC will grant us more time in order to get the lien from Steve and Janet Adams satisfied.
