PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated November 16,, 2010, this matter was set for hearing on June 14, 2011, and a procedural schedule for filing testimony was established.

On April 5, 2011, Goodman Water Company (“GWC” or the “Company”) filed a Motion for Limited Revision of Procedural Deadlines for Filing Testimony. The Company stated that it required additional time to prepare Rebuttal Testimony in response to the issue of land value appraisal raised by one of the witnesses for the Arizona Corporation Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”). The Company proposed a modification of the schedule for filing testimony that would extend the deadline for fling testimony related to the one issue of land value appraisals, but keeping the original deadlines for all other topics.

On April 6, 2011, the Residential Utility Consumer Office (“RUCO”) filed a Response to the Company’s Motion. RUCO proposed an alternate schedule that would extend all filing dates. RUCO believed that dividing the issues and setting alternative filing dates for different issues would result in more work for the parties and lead to waste. RUCO reports that the Company and Staff support RUCO’s proposed dates, but that it had not heard from any of the other intervenors.

Extending the testimony filing deadlines will promote a more thorough and accurate record and is in the public interest. RUCO’s proposed compromise schedule appears reasonable and should

1 not prejudice any party. Consequently, the filing deadlines originally set in the November 16, 2010,
2 Procedural Order will be modified as set forth below.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **schedule for filing testimony is modified as**
4 **follows:**




