On May 6, 2009, IntelePeer Access, LLC ("IntelePeer") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold long distance, resold local exchange, facilities-based local exchange, and facilities-based long distance telecommunication services in Arizona. IntelePeer also petitioned the commission for a determination that its proposed services are competitive in Arizona. Subsequently, IntelePeer amended its application to seek authority also to provide switched access telecommunication services in Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended approval of IntelePeer's application subject to certain conditions. The Commission will issue a Decision following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by IntelePeer, Staff, or any intervenors. IntelePeer will be required to provide service under the rates, terms, and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of the application, Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report filed by IntelePeer or intervenor(s) will be available at IntelePeer's offices, 2300 15th Street, Suite 100, Denver, CO 80202, and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function. The Commission will hold a hearing on IntelePeer's application on May 12, 2011, at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Room Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (go to <http://www.azcc.gov/Divisions/Utilities/consumerservices.asp> for instructions) or by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-20695A-09-0387 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to IntelePeer or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed before April 18, 2011. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. If representation by counsel is required by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 3.1, intervention

will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. 
