As a stand alone water company, East Slope does not need anywhere near \$3,000,000.00 in long-term debt to finance repairs and improvements. Indeed, once the wells are drilled and placed in service minimal expenses are incurred for repairs and improvements.

While it is prudent to have funds available for planned projects, upgrades, new wells, etc., East Slope Water Co. should be limited in their long-term debt to a reasonable, conservative level and be required to show verifiable progress on projects as well as proactive measures to prevent a water shortage (as we have with natural gas recently - February, 2011).
