On March 16, 2011, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Weldon Beall, and Weldon LLC, an Arizona limited liability company ("Weldon"), (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On April 27, 2011, a request for hearing and an Answer were filed by on behalf of the Respondents.

Accordingly, a pre-hearing conference should be scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **pre-hearing conference** shall be held on **May 26, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, **2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Room**, Phoenix, Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the

1 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances  
2 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is  
3 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
4 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
6 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission  
7 *pro hac vice*.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
9 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


