**Summary**

The Cerbat Water Company ("CWC") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a permanent rate increase, using a calendar year 2009 test year ("TY"). In its application, CWC reports TY gross revenues of \$107,339 and total TY operating expenses of \$136,633. CWC requests an increase in revenues of \$57,946 and is proposing rates which will increase a typical residential bill for a customer with a 3/4-inch meter with median usage of 4,569 gallons of water per month from \$25.54 to \$38.78 per month.

The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has issued a Staff Report which recommends an increase in CWC's revenues of \$18,052 and proposes rates which will increase a typical residential bill for a customer with a 3/4-inch meter with median usage of 4,569 gallons of water per month from \$25.54 to \$26.02 per month.

The Commission will determine the appropriate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record obtained through a hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by CWC or Staff. The final rates approved by the Commission may be higher or lower than those proposed by CWC or recommended by Staff.


