PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Schedules Pre-Hearing Conference)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 2, 2011, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Kent M. Axtell, individually and dba Sherlock Homes and Finding Homes for Investors, and Janis C. Axtell, husband and wife, and Executive Real Estate Solutions, L.L.C., an Arizona limited liability company ("Executive") (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of notes and investment contracts.

Respondent's spouse was named in the action solely for purposes of determining the liability of the marital community pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-2031(C).

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On May 20, 2011, a request for hearing was filed by Respondents.

Accordingly, a pre-hearing conference should be scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **pre-hearing conference** shall be held on **June 20, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, **Hearing Room No. 1**, Phoenix, Arizona.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
2 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
4 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
5 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
6 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
7 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
8 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
10 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission
11 *pro hac vice*.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request for discovery shall be taken under
13 advisement.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
15 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


