

**STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY AND
FOR WAIVER OF TIME CLOCK**

On November 3, 2010, Doney Park Water Company, Inc. ("Doney Park" or "the Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a permanent rate increase.


On December 9, 2010, a procedural order was issued directing Staff to file testimony and associated exhibits to be presented at hearing by Staff to be reduced to writing and filed on or before June 6, 2011.

On February 18, 2011, Staff submitted its First Set of Data Requests to Doney Park Water Company, with a response deadline of ten calendar days later. Because the Company had not sought a rate increase since 1994, it was required to provide numerous documents that were in storage. The Company requested and Staff agreed to an extension of the time to respond until March 10, 2011. Although the Company has submitted some of the requested documents, it has advised Staff that it will not be able to provide the remaining documents until June 24, 2011, which is more than two weeks after Staff's Direct Testimony is to be filed.

Staff understands the difficulty the Company is experiencing in retrieving documents for a fifteen year period, but those documents are required for Staff to evaluate the Company's application. Staff will require at least 45 days after receiving these documents to review them and to prepare and file testimony. As a result of the delay, the schedule for filing of testimony and for hearing cannot be met.

1 Staff requests that its deadline for filing its direct testimony and exhibits be extended by at
2 least 45 days; that the schedule set forth in the Procedural Order of December 9, 2010, be adjusted
3 accordingly, including the rescheduling of the hearing dates; and that the time clock be waived until
4 such time as the Company has provided its complete responses to Staff's First Set of Data Requests.
