PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Administratively Closes Docket)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 25, 2005, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision No. 68238 which granted an Order Preliminary to the issuance of an extension to its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”) to Chaparral City Water Company, Inc. (“Chaparral” or “Company”) for approximately 1,300 acres of State trust land. Pursuant to the Decision, compliance with various regulatory approvals and filing deadlines were to be completed no later than October 28, 2008.

In Decision No. 70608 (November 12, 2008), the Commission extended the deadline for compliance with the Order Preliminary to April 25, 2010.

In Decision No. 71824 (August 10, 2010), the Commission granted Chaparral a further extension of the compliance deadline, until February 1, 2011.

On March 2, 2011, the Company filed a Request for Extension of Deadlines seeking a further extension until July 1, 2011. Chaparral claimed that it did not have sufficient information to file its most recent extension request by the February 1, 2011 deadline. The Company states that it has made significant progress in meeting the compliance requirements, and that the additional extension would not harm existing customers.

On March 14, 2011, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) filed a Memorandum recommending that Chaparral be required to file a new CC&N extension application because the

1 Company failed to meet the compliance requirements despite being granted two prior extensions
2 beyond the original compliance deadline. Staff also recommended that the above-captioned docket
3 be administratively closed.

4 To date, no filings have been received responding to Staff's recommendations to deny the
5 extension request and to administratively close the docket.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Docket No. W-02113A-05-0178** is hereby
7 **administratively closed.**

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
