To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the above referenced decision, Woodruff Water Company, Inc. is requesting an amendment to the compliance requirements, such that a rate application need not be filed until project development commences.

Woodruff Water Company, Inc. was originally formed to provide public water to a 3,200 acre, master-planned subdivision, to be known as Sandia. In late 2009, ownership and management for the entities owning the property for the community, as well as the water company, was transferred by the original developer. Given the current economic state and lack of demand for new residential development, there are no plans to develop the community any time in the near future, nor will the facility provide public water services in the near future.

If the Commission doesn't feel a compliance amendment is in order, Woodruff Water Company, Inc. respectfully requests a five-year extension to submit a rate application.
