Specific Comments

Page 18, Section 2.1.2.1

Last paragraph of section - SRP is providing some additional information on WIRAB, as requested by KEMA, for inclusion in the report.

The Western Interconnection Regional Advisory Body (WIRAB) was created by Western Governors under Section 215 of the Federal Power Act and was approved by FERC in July 2006. The WIRAB is to advise WECC, the ERO and FERC on whether proposed reliability standards and the governance and budgets of the ERO and WECC are in the public interest as well as to consult with DOE on the designation of national interest transmission corridors. FERC may request that WIRAB provide advice on other topics. Members include representatives from the states of Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington and Wyoming, the Canadian provinces of Alberta and British Columbia, and Mexico. Page 32, Section 3.1.2.1

Figure 1 – Figure 1 appears to be a future condition, assuming certain additions and does not reflect 2005 transfer capabilities. The East of River Path (Path 49) between Arizona and California/Southern Nevada in 2005 is 7550 and not 9000+ as shown in Figure 1. Figure 1 needs to be replaced with the correct data for 2005.

Page 38, Section 3.2.1

Figure 3 - This is an older map of the sub-regional planning groups. Additionally, WECC has requested it no longer be used due to the proprietary map background. SRP is providing a graphic of a new updated sub-regional planning groups map that can be used in its place.


Page 44, Section 3.2.1.3

SRP suggests the following sentence be added at the end of this paragraph “SSG-WI has been terminated and the planning activities have been incorporated into the WECC Transmission Expansion Planning Policy Committee responsibilities.”

Page 113, Section 9

Table 17 – Remove “Santa Cruz Water and Power Districts” from the list of participants for the Hassayampa-Pinal West and Pinal West-Southeast Valley/Browning Projects but keep “ED2, ED3 and ED4” in the listing of participants.
