BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Pursuant to Decision No. 64721 (April 17, 2002), ATMC, Inc. ("ATMC" or "Company") was granted a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona.

2. On February 28, 2008, the Company filed with the Commission an application for the cancellation of its Certificate ("Application"). ATMC stated that it had not provided service in Arizona for several years, and is withdrawing all tariffs and certifications for doing business in Arizona.

3. On November 22, 2010, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed its Staff Report recommending approval of ATMC's Application.

4. Staff states that the Company did not collect advances, deposits and/or prepayments from Arizona customers.

5. Staff reported that there were no customer complaints, inquiries or opinions against the Company and Staff noted that the Commission's Corporations Division had revoked ATMC's

1 ability to transact business in Arizona on December 12, 2008, for failure to file its annual report.

2 6. Staff recommends approval of ATMC's Application and cancellation of the
3 Company's Certificate.

4 7. Staff's recommendations are reasonable and should be adopted.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. The Company is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
7 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

8 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Company and the subject matter of the
9 Application.

10 3. The cancellation of the Company's Certificate is in the public interest and the
11 Application should be granted as recommended by Staff.

12 4. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue decisions regarding
13 Certificates of Convenience and Necessity for certain telecommunication services without a hearing.

14 5. The requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-1107 should be waived in this case.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application of ATMC, Inc. for the cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona is approved, and its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity is hereby cancelled.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ATMC, Inc. is hereby granted a waiver of A.A.C. R14-2-1107.


