On January 30, 2010, I was in attendance at the Montezuma Estates Property Owners' Association meeting regarding the future plans for the Montzuma Rimrock Water Company. The meeting began in an informative manner with Patsy and Greg Olsen presenting the future plans for well sites and the arsenic treatment system. In attendance were two men, John Dougherty and Ivo Buddeke, both of whom are on private wells and do not make use of the water from MRWC. The meeting began calmly enough, however John Dougherty became increasingly agitated. He complained that Well Site #4, visable from his home, was unsightly because of the chainlink fence, topped by "razor wire". It was pointed out that the fence is topped by barbed wire, required by law, and that his next door neighbor's home is also surrounded by chainlink fencing, but that doesn't seem to be a problem.

John had a stack of papers which he said contained evidence that The Olsens were deceitful in running the water company. John climaxed his remarks with "We should get a decent water company, like Arizona Water Company to run the business." This struck me like a bolt of lightning. Is he working for Arizona Water Company??? Is he trying to destroy Mrs. Olsen's business so that Arizona Water Company or someone else can pick up the business for cheap?

People began to interrupt each other so that the President of MEPOA brought out a ball which was given to whomever was speaking so that people could listen and stop interrupting each other. When Patsy Olsen was holding the ball and answering questions which had been presented, John continously interrupted her in a loud manner, finally grabbing his papers and storming out of the meeting like a two-year-old. As he was leaving, John approached Greg Olsen in anger. At this point a lady got out her cell phone to call 911. The President, Steve, stepped in to prevent a fight and John left.

In these following weeks, John's and Ivo's criticisms of the Water Company have shifted from one objection to another, relentlessly placing obstacles in the path of MRWC, keeping them from moving forward with the arsenic treatment system, developing Well Site #4 and providing the area with an adequate water supply for family use and fire fighting. **The focus of thier objections changes on a weekly basis, supporting the idea that they may have an ulterior motive.** John and Ivo seem determined to halt the progress of MRWC and keep the company from succeeding in providing safe drinking water and adequate fire protection at a reasonable price.
