**MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME**

McGraw Communications, Inc. ("McGraw") requests an extension of time until August 15, 2011 to obtain a performance bond or letter of credit. McGraw received a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Decision No. 72184 (Feb. 11, 2011). That decision requires McGraw to obtain a "performance bond or irrevocable sight draft letter of credit in the amount of \$125,000" and to submit the bond or letter of credit to the ACC "within 90 days of the effective date of this Decision or 10 days prior to serving its first customer."

McGraw requests an extension of time to comply with this requirement. McGraw has diligently attempted to obtain a bond or letter of credit. McGraw originally decided to pursue a letter of credit. However, obtaining a letter of credit from McGraw's bank (JP Morgan Chase) took longer than anticipated due to several paperwork and documentation issues. Moreover, the terms of the letter of credit offered by the bank were ultimately not acceptable to McGraw. For this reason, McGraw is now pursuing a performance bond. McGraw is diligently pursuing a performance bond, and believes that it can have a bond in place within a few weeks.

An extension of time will pose no risk to customers. McGraw has not yet started to serve customers in Arizona, and it will not provide service in Arizona until after the proposed August 15, 2011 due date. Moreover, as noted in Finding of Fact No. 43 of Decision No. 72148, McGraw

3 For these reasons, McGraw seeks a brief extension of time until August 15, 2011 to obtain
4 the required performance bond.
