**APPLICANT TUSAYAN WATER
DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATION, INC.’S
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
FILE DIRECT TESTIMONY**

(Administrative Law Judge Sarah N. Harpring)

Applicant Tusayan Water Development Association, Inc. (“TWDA”), through its counsel, pursuant to A.A.C. § R14-3-106(K), hereby moves for an extension of time to file its direct testimony. On Monday, June 20, 2011, the due date, TWDA attempted to file the direct testimony of Christopher Brainard by delivering (through a commercial courier) an original and three copies of that document to the Arizona Corporation Commission (“ACC”). Under A.A.C. § R14-3-107(A), a filer is to include an original and three copies of formal documents for filing.

On June 22, 2011, counsel undersigned received a phone call from Garry Hays, counsel for Intervenor Tusayan Ventures LLC (“T Ventures”) regarding TWDA’s attempted filing. Mr. Hays advised counsel undersigned that the docket control office/counter requires an original and thirteen copies of filings and that any shortage of copies may result in rejection of the filing. Mr.

1 Hays observed that the eDocket for TWDA's docket included the direct testimony filings of
2 Applicants Hydro-Resources, Inc. ("Hydro") and Anasazi Water Co., LLC ("Anasazi"), but not
3 TWDA.

4 Counsel undersigned was unfamiliar with the practice of the ACC's docket control only
5 to accept filings supplied with thirteen copies. Counsel undersigned has alleviated this concern
6 by re-filing the direct testimony with adequate copies, contemporaneously with this motion.
7 Counsel undersigned contacted the Applicants' and Intervenors' counsel to request their consent
8 to granting a two-day extension of time to file this direct testimony, since they had already
9 received their copies of the direct testimony by mail. The extension of time requested will not
10 prejudice any party to these dockets. TWDA does not anticipate any objection.
