

25 **SUPPLEMENTAL FILING IN SUPPORT OF ITS**
26 **EXCEPTIONS TO RECOMMENDED OPINION AND ORDER**

27 On February 22, 2011, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-110(B) and the Procedural Order in
28 this matter dated January 11, 2011, Arizona Water Company submitted certain exceptions to

1 the Recommended Opinion and Order (“ROO”) issued on December 22, 2010. On May 11,
2 2011, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued a Procedural Order
3 directing Arizona Water Company to file “an amended map(s) and documentation”
4 providing additional details and information supporting Arizona Water Company’s
5 exceptions. May 11, 2011 Procedural Order at 3, line 15. Arizona Water Company submits
6 this filing in compliance with the Commission’s direction. Specifically, an amended Exhibit
7 A is being provided that clearly calls out township designations. Additionally, as to each
8 area of the revised Pinal Valley map that is the subject of a specific exception or comment,
9 an individual map, including orientation to the larger regional map, is provided within this
10 exception document.

11 **I. The ROO Should Be Amended to Correct Discrepancies between the text of the**
12 **ROO and the Exhibit F Map Concerning Certain Parcels.**

13 The following items describe instances where the text of the ROO appears to differ
14 from what is shown on Exhibit F, the map that shows the parcels that would be included in
15 Arizona Water Company’s CCN.


16 1. T06S, R05E, northeast portion of Section 5 (Identified as “Parcel 4” in
17 Arizona Water Company Ex. WMG-14 (the “Garfield Map Exhibit”)¹ (See Figure I-1 that
18 follows). Both Staff and the ROO recommend including this parcel in Arizona Water
19 Company’s CCN area. See ROO, ¶ 102. However, Exhibit F does not show the parcel as
20 being part of Arizona Water Company’s new CCN area. Therefore, Exhibit F should be
21 revised to conform to the text of the ROO (i.e., the pink color of this area should become
22 brown, for “Arizona Water – ROO Recommended”).

27 ¹ The Garfield Map Exhibit is separately attached for the Commission’s convenience
28 to these supplemental exceptions as Exhibit B.

1 2. T06S R03E, west half of Section 26 (Area North & West of Parcel 7/East of
2 Portion of Parcel B/South of E on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-2 that follows).
3 Both Staff and the ROO recommend including Parcel 7 (as shown on the Garfield Map
4 Exhibit) in Arizona Water Company's CCN area, and the ROO recommends including this
5 portion of Parcel B and Parcel E. ROO, ¶¶ 105, 108. The area is completely surrounded by
6 Arizona Water Company's CCN, and Exhibit F properly shows the west half of Section 26
7 as being included. However, the text of the ROO does not specifically mention this parcel,
8 ROO ¶ 108, and should do so to confirm that it is included in Arizona Water Company's
9 recommended CCN area.




1 3. T07S R03E, Section 1 (Area surrounded by Parcels 10, 11, 13, 16, 18 and a
2 portion of B on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-3 that follows). Exhibit F properly
3 shows this area included in Arizona Water Company's CCN. The ROO should be revised to
4 track what is shown in Exhibit F and to confirm that this area is included in Arizona Water
5 Company's recommended CCN area. ROO, ¶¶ 112-114.




1 4. T07S R04E, west half of Section 3 (Area North of Parcel 8/East of Parcel 9 on
2 the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-4 that follows). Both Staff and the ROO
3 recommend including Parcels 8 and 9 as shown in the Garfield Map Exhibit in Arizona
4 Water Company's recommended CCN area. ROO, ¶ 102. This leaves a small parcel
5 completely surrounded by Arizona Water Company's CCN area. Exhibit F shows it as
6 included, but the text of the ROO does not mention it. The text of the ROO should be
7 revised to track what is shown in Exhibit F and to confirm that the area is included in
8 Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN area.




1 5. T07S R04E, east half of Section 10 (Area South of Parcel 8/North & West of
2 Parcel 14 on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-5 that follows). This area is entirely
3 within the Palo Verde Utilities 208 Plan Area, and the ROO included Parcels 8 and 14 as
4 shown on the Garfield Map Exhibit in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN area.
5 However, this leaves a parcel surrounded on three sides by Arizona Water Company's CCN.
6 Exhibit F shows the parcel as included in Arizona Water Company's CCN, but the text of
7 the ROO does not mention it. The text of the ROO should be revised to track what is shown
8 in Exhibit F and to confirm that this area is included in Arizona Water Company's
9 recommended CCN area.




1 6. T07S R04E, southern portion of Section 8 (Area South and East of Parcel 12
2 on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-6 that follows). Exhibit F does not show this
3 area as included in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN area, but the text of the
4 ROO appears to include it. ROO, ¶ 111. Exhibit F should be revised to show that this area
5 is included within Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN.




1 7. T07S R05E, east half of Section 19 (Area south of Parcel D on the Garfield
2 Map Exhibit) (See Figure I-7 that follows). The ROO recommends including Parcel D in
3 Arizona Water Company's CCN area, and this half section also should be included to round
4 out Arizona Water Company's CCN area. Exhibit F shows the half section as included.
5 The text of the ROO should be revised to track Exhibit F and to confirm that the half section
6 is included in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN area. See ROO, ¶ 107.

2 **II. The ROO Should Be Amended to Correct an Instance in Which It Erroneously**
3 **Refers to the Absence of Testimony Support at the Hearing.**

4 T06S R03E, southwest corner of Section 28 (Northeast corner of John Wayne
5 Parkway and Peters Road on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure II-1 that follows).
6 Global agreed to transfer this CCN area to Arizona Water Company, as confirmed in the
7 testimony of Graham Symmonds of Global during examination by counsel for Global. See
8 6/9/2009 Transcript at 229. However, the ROO incorrectly states that there was no
9 testimony about transferring this parcel. ROO, ¶ 124. In addition, there was no opposition
10 to transferring this CCN area to Arizona Water Company. This parcel should be included in
11 Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN area, as should the rest of Section 28, since
12 the southwest corner of the section would otherwise be isolated from Arizona Water
13 Company's CCN and water system.

2 **III. The ROO Should Be Amended to Include Certain Additional Areas in Arizona**
3 **Water Company's Recommended CCN Which, by Reason of Geography, Sound**
4 **Engineering Principles and Public Policy Should Be Included.**

5 The ROO should be revised to include certain additional areas in Arizona Water
6 Company's CCN. Following a review of the currently recommended portions of the CCN
7 as adjusted above, geography, sound utility engineering principles and good public planning
8 strongly suggest that these additional areas be included within Arizona Water Company's
9 recommended CCN. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84, 120, 149-52 (Garfield testimony on
10 "rounding off" CCN areas to encourage operational efficiencies); 6/8/2009 Transcript at
11 207-08 (Schneider testimony on "rounding off" CCN areas); 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56
12 (Gray testimony acknowledging value of "rounding off" CCN areas in some cases). All of
13 these areas are located within the Palo Verde Utilities 208 Plan Area, with the exception of
14 the south half of Section 25, identified in paragraph 6, below.

15 1. T06S R03E, Sections 10, 14 & 15 (See Figure III-1 that follows). By
16 including Section 16 of this township in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN (as
17 shown in Exhibit F), this particular area is now surrounded on three sides by Arizona Water
18 Company's CCN, and should be included in the CCN to round off the area and provide a
19 more logical CCN boundary. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; *see*
20 *also* 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.





1 2. T06S R03E, Section 34 (See Figure III-2 that follows). Similarly, by
2 including the adjacent sections in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN (as shown
3 in Exhibit F), this particular area is now surrounded by Arizona Water Company's CCN on
4 three sides and should be included in the CCN in order to round off Arizona Water
5 Company's CCN area and provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See 6/8/2009 Transcript*
6 *at 82-84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; see also 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.*

3. T06S R03E, Sections 21 and 22 (See Figure III-3 that follows). If the additional areas mentioned above are included, this area would likewise be surrounded on three sides by Arizona Water Company's CCN. Additionally, Section 22 has an irregularly-shaped spur jutting into the CCN area. Both of these sections should be included in Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN to round it off in this area and provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; *see also* 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.





2 This area is almost completely surrounded by Arizona Water Company recommended CCN
3 and should be included within Arizona Water Company's CCN to round off the CCN area at
4 this location and provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84,
5 120, 149-52, 207-08; *see also* 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.



1 6. T07S R04E, Sections 24 & 25 (See Figure III-6 that follows). This area is
2 adjacent to Arizona Water Company's recommended CCN to the north and south.
3 Moreover, Arizona Water Company's water lines must cross this area to reach the portion of
4 Parcel B (as shown on the Garfield Map Exhibit) that is being added to Arizona Water
5 Company's CCN. Although the south half of Section 25 is currently outside of Global's
6 208 Plan Area (the rest of these sections are within that Area), Global witnesses testified
7 that Global would amend their 208 Plan Area to include the Arizona State Land Department
8 parcels upon request for service. Therefore, these areas should also be included in Arizona
9 Water Company's recommended CCN area to provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See*
10 *6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; see also 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.*





1 **IV. The Finding in the ROO that Areas Within the City of Casa Grande 208**
2 **Planning Area Are Not Certain to be Provided Sewer Service Should Be**
3 **Eliminated.**

4 As noted in the March 2, 2011 Letter from the City of Casa Grande to Chairman
5 Gary Pierce (attached as Exhibit C), the City of Casa Grande plans to provide sewer service
6 to relevant properties east of Montgomery Road under its 208 Plan. Therefore, the
7 following areas within the City of Casa Grande's 208 Plan Area boundaries—for which
8 Arizona Water Company has received requests for service—should be included in Arizona
9 Water Company's recommended CCN area:

10 1. T07S R05E, Section 13 (Parcels 1, 2 & 3 of the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See
11 Figure IV-1 that follows). Parcels 1, 2 and 3 are all small parcels for which Arizona Water
12 Company received requests for service in 2006. They are immediately contiguous to
13 Arizona Water Company's existing Casa Grande CCN area and lie within Casa Grande's
14 208 Plan Area boundaries, meaning that both Casa Grande and the Arizona Department of
15 Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") expect the City of Casa Grande to provide wastewater
16 service to those parcels. For the reasons set forth above, these parcels should be included in
17 Arizona Water Company's Casa Grande CCN area. Additionally, to round off the CCN in
18 this area, the entirety of Section 13 should be included in the Company's recommended
19 CCN area in order to provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-
20 84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; *see also* 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.

2. T07S R05E, Sections 15, 16, 17, 20, 21 & 23 (including Parcels A and portions of B and D on the Garfield Map Exhibit) (See Figure IV-2 that follows). These areas are contiguous or very near to Arizona Water Company's existing Casa Grande CCN area and within Casa Grande's 208 Plan Area, meaning that Casa Grande and ADEQ expect the City of Casa Grande to provide wastewater service to these parcels. Arizona Water Company received requests for service for these areas, or the substantial portion of certain of these sections. For the reasons set forth above, the parcels should be included in Arizona Water Company's Casa Grande CCN area.





3. T07S R05E, Sections 14 and 22 (See Figure IV-3 that follows). If the areas described in paragraphs 1 and 2, above, are included in Arizona Water Company's CCN area, then these sections would be surrounded on three sides (or in the case of Section 14, completely surrounded) by Arizona Water Company's CCN area, and both sections should be included in the Company's recommended CCN area in order to provide a more logical CCN boundary. *See* 6/8/2009 Transcript at 82-84, 120, 149-52, 207-08; *see also* 6/9/2009 Transcript at 353-56.








Arizona Water Company (the "Company"), hereby files a copy of a March 2, 2011 letter from Bob Jackson, Mayor of the City of Casa Grande (the "City") to Gary Pierce, Chairman of the Commission. The copy of that letter is Attachment A hereto (the "City's Letter").

The Consolidated Proceedings in the above-captioned dockets were the culmination of several applications for certificates of convenience and necessity ("CCNs") and certain related matters. The Consolidated Proceedings involved a number of proceedings over the course of several years, and included hearings which concluded in June 2009. A comprehensive recommended opinion and order in the Consolidated Proceedings, entered by Administrative Law Judge Yvette Kinsey on December 22, 2010, is now pending before the Commission.

1 The issues in the Consolidated Proceedings included the ability to use reclaimed
2 wastewater in the CCN areas, the availability of wastewater service in the CCN areas, and the
3 identification of the providers of wastewater service. A related issue, particularly concerning the
4 Company's application for additional CCN area, was the scope and boundaries of the City's 208
5 Plan (ROO, pages 38-39). In particular, at lines 15-17, page 38 of the ROO, the ROO included the
6 statement that "...it is unclear when or if (the City) will provide wastewater service to the area
7 (i.e., certain areas within the City limits)..."

8
9 The City's letter clarifies its intentions in that regard, and, the Company submits, clearly
10 establishes the City's intent to provide wastewater service to all of the area located within its City
11 limits, including any future expansion of the City limits. Mayor Jackson appeared to have sent his
12 letter only to Chairman Pierce. The Company is now filing the City's letter to document that
13 clarification, for the benefit of the Commission, the City, and all of the parties to the Consolidated
14 Proceedings. The Company further submits that, as the ROO has not been adopted by the
15 Commission, or yet included on an open meeting agenda, this filing will not prejudice the interest
16 of any party to the Consolidated Proceedings.

The City of Casa Grande is the Designated Management Agency by the Central Arizona Association of Governments (CAAG) for the provision of wastewater services in the area described on the attached map (generally east of Montgomery Road in the area south of Interstate 10). On August 6, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 4075, approving the Wastewater Master Plan Phase I Conceptual Plan, specifically Option 4 thereof, as a guideline for providing wastewater collection and treatment in the City. This option, developed for the City by Carollo Engineers in an August, 2006 report, provided a master plan for the provision of wastewater services in the region pursuant to the Clean Water Act, Section 208.

In 2009, the Environmental Planning Committee of CAAG, the designated Section 208 agency for this area of the State of Arizona, recommended approval of amendments to the CAAG Section 208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan naming the City as the Designated Management Agency for this defined region. This designation was formally adopted by CAAG in Resolution No. 2009-5 on September 11, 2009.


Since that action, the City has been the designated wastewater provider east of Montgomery Road in this region, and will extend wastewater service to properties in this region pursuant to its obligations under Section 208 of the Clean Water Act.


