IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF CRICKET COMMUNICATIONS, INC. FOR DESIGNATION AS AN ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER IN THE STATE OF ARIZONA. (DOCKET NO. T-20721A-10-0019)

On January 28, 2010, Cricket Communications, Inc., ("Cricket" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier ("ETC") to provide Lifeline and Link-Up services to low income customers in Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended approval of Cricket's application, subject to certain conditions. The Commission may issue a Decision on Cricket's application without a hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by Cricket, Staff, or any intervenors. Copies of the application, Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report filed by Cricket will be available at Cricket's offices, 5887 Copley Drive, San Diego, California 92111 and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on Cricket's application on August 22, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (go to http://www.azcc.gov/Divisions/Utilities/consumerservice.s.asp for instructions) or by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-20721A-10-0019 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to Cricket or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor;
- 2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and
- 3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before July 22, 2011. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. If representation by counsel is required by Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31 and 38, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. Persons with a disability may request a reasonable accommodation such as a sign language interpreter, as well as request this document in an alternative format, by contacting the ADA Coordinator, Shaylin Bernal at SBernal@azcc.gov, voice phone number 602-542-3931. Requests should be made as early as possible to allow time to arrange the accommodation.


