PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Continues Hearing)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 18, 2011, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Attila G. Toth (CRD# 2565633) and Erin M. Hall, husband and wife (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of notes and stock. Respondent Attila Toth's spouse, Erin M. Hall, was joined in the action for purposes of determining the liability of the marital community.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On January 27, 2011, Respondent, Attila G. Toth, filed a request for hearing in this matter.

On January 28, 2011, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on February 23, 2011.

On February 23, 2011, the Division appeared through counsel and Respondent Attila G. Toth appeared on his own behalf. Counsel for the Division indicated that the parties were attempting to reach a settlement in the proceeding and would submit a proposed form of Consent Order for approval by the Commission. In the interim, the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled in the event that the parties did not reach a resolution of the issues raised by the Notice.

On February 24, 2011, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled to commence on May 26, 2011.

1 On February 28, 2011, the Division filed a Motion to Continue (“Motion”) the hearing due to
2 the unavailability of a witness in the proceeding. There were no objections filed to the Division’s
3 Motion.

4 On March 22, 2011, by Procedural Order, the Motion was granted and the hearing was
5 continued to June 28, 2011.

6 On June 27, 2011, the Division filed another Motion requesting an additional continuance
7 stating that Respondents had executed a consent agreement which is to be submitted to the
8 Commission in the form of a Consent Order for the Commission’s approval at the next Securities
9 Open Meeting. If the Consent Order is approved by the Commission, the Division will file a Motion
10 to Vacate the proceeding.

11 Accordingly, the hearing should be continued pending approval of a proposed Consent Order.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing shall be continued from June 28, 2011, to**
13 **August 22, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission’s offices, 1200 West Washington Street,
14 **Room 100**, Phoenix, Arizona.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall reserve **August 23, 2011**, for an additional
16 day of hearing, if necessary.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **if the case is resolved by a proposed Consent Order**
18 **prior to the hearing, the Division shall file a Motion to Vacate the Proceeding.**

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
20 Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission’s Decision in this
21 matter is final and non-appealable.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
23 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
24 *pro hac vice*.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
26 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
27 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
28 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is

1 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
2 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
4 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
5 ruling at hearing.


