PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 22, 2010, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for authorization for the purchase of generating assets from Southern California Edison ("SCE") and for an accounting order. The application seeks authority for APS to acquire SCE's interest in the Four Corners Power Plant.

By Procedural Orders, intervention has been granted to the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"), the Arizona Competitive Power Alliance (the "Alliance"), Western Resource Advocates ("WRA"), Southwestern Power Group II, L.L.C. and Bowie Power Station, L.L.C. ("SWPG/Bowie") and the Environmental Defense Fund ("EDF").

On May 31, 2011, SWPG/Bowie filed a Motion to Withdraw as an Intervenor ("Motion") and the Alliance filed a Notice of Substitution of Counsel, designating Lawrence V. Robertson, Jr. as counsel for the Alliance.

On June 21, 2011, by Procedural Order, the Motion was granted, and one of the additional days of hearing was modified.

On June 24, 2011, Staff filed a Request for a Pre-Hearing Conference.

On June 27, 2011, the Alliance's counsel filed a letter dated June 23, 2011, indicating that he would be unavailable to attend a Procedural Conference during specific dates, and further indicating that the Alliance's Executive Director would be available to serve as a spokesperson for the Alliance.

Accordingly, a pre-hearing conference should be scheduled.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **pre-hearing conference** in the above-captioned  
2 matter shall commence on **June 30, 2011 at 1:30 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the  
3 Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, **Hearing Room #1**, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized  
5 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
7 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
9 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
