Project Description: This project includes the installation of a skid mounted booster pump system, a block building and associated piping. The booster skid consists of 3-7.5 HP pumps. A 40 Hp fire pump is located in the corner of the building. The building is constructed of block and is 33' X 24'. The project also includes 280 lf of 2", 190 lf of 3", 780' lf of 4" and 400 lf of 6" pipe. A 2,500 gallon hydro tank is located in the building that controls the pumps.	

Approval to operate the above-described facilities (as represented in the approved plan documents on file with the Yavapai County Development Services-Environmental Unit) is hereby given, subject to the following provisions:

- Approval is based on the "As -Built" drawings and Engineer's Certificate of Completion signed and dated May 2, 2011 by Robert D. Upton PE.
- System must have an agreement with an appropriate Certified Operator for system operation.
- This approval does not supersede or eliminate the necessity of obtaining permits or approvals from other county, state or federal agencies or departments.
- Issuance of this "Approval to Operate" does not authorize construction in any County, Town, City or State road rights-of-way for this project. A separate permit may be required. Please contact the regulatory highway department for this permit.

State law, A.R.S. 49-104, B.10, requires that the operation of the project must be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality.

APPROVAL OF CONSTRUCTION

Project Description: Groom Creek Water Users. AOC Permit for one 65,000 gallon galvanized NSF approved storage tank to serve the Groom Creek Water Users Association.

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) hereby issues an Approval of Construction for the above-described facility based on the following provisions of Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C.) R18-5-507 et seq.

On March 16, 2010, ADEQ issued a Certificate of Approval to Construct for the referenced project.

On May 16, 2011 K.J. Miller, P.E., certified the following:

- A final construction inspection was conducted on May 14, 2011;
- The referenced project was constructed according to the as-built plans and specifications and ADEQ's Certificate of Approval to Construct;
- The water storage system was disinfected according to an ADEQ-approved method; and
- The applicant has the right to appeal this AOC Permit. Appeal information is on reverse side of this Permit.

Microbiological samples were collected on June 10, 2011, and analyzed on June 11, 2011 by Bradshaw Mountain Environmental Laboratory, ADHS License No. AZ0029. The sample results were negative for total coliform.

This Approval of Construction authorizes the owner to begin operating the above-described facilities as represented in the approved plan on file with the ADEQ. Be advised that A.A.C. R18-5-124 requires the owner of a public water system to maintain and operate all water production, treatment and distribution facilities in accordance with ADEQ Safe Drinking Water Rules.
