

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING ON THE RATE APPLICATION OF CHINO
MEADOWS II WATER COMPANY DOCKET NO. W-02370A-10-0519**

On December 30, 2010, Chino Meadows II Water Company ("Chino Meadows" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a permanent gross revenue increase of **\$84,640, or 24 percent** over test year revenues. **Under the rates as proposed by the Company, a residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4" meter, with an average monthly usage of 5,387 gallons, would see a monthly increase of \$6.27, or 19.32 percent, from \$32.44 to \$38.71.** A customer's bill depends on meter size and how much water is used each month. A customer using less or more than the average would experience a smaller or larger increase.

The Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") is in the process of auditing and analyzing the application and has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Company's rate proposal. The Commission will determine the appropriate rate relief to be granted based on the evidence of record in this proceeding. **THE COMMISSION IS NOT BOUND BY THE PROPOSALS MADE BY THE COMPANY, STAFF, OR ANY INTERVENORS AND, THEREFORE, THE FINAL RATES APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION MAY DIFFER FROM THE RATES REQUESTED BY THE COMPANY OR OTHER PARTIES.**

Public Hearing Information

The Commission will hold a **hearing** on this matter beginning **October 3, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.** at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, **Hearing Room No. 1**, Phoenix, Arizona.

Public comments will be taken at the beginning of the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. W-02370A-10-0519 to Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007, or by email. About Intervention

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you wish to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than **August 1, 2011**, and a copy of the motion to Chino Meadows or its counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address and telephone number of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself.
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 1, 2011. If representation by counsel is required by Rule 31 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments in the record of the case.


