STAFF'S REQUEST FOR PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 1, 2011, the Commission Staff found Arizona Public Service Company's ("APS" or "Company") application to be sufficient. The Hearing Division has scheduled a Procedural Conference for July 18, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. to discuss hearing dates and other procedural issues. Staff files this request for a procedural schedule to govern further processing of the Company's application. Staff has conferred with APS on the proposed schedule and the Company is agreeable to it.

¹ In the event that a settlement is not reached, APS shall file its Rebuttal Testimony at the earliest practical date. The schedule will then use the same time intervals from the point of APS' filing of its Rebuttal Testimony as are contained in the Non-Settlement Schedule. If the parties elect to continue settlement discussions beyond December 16, 2011, the dates in the Settlement schedule will be lengthened by the number of days that discussions continued beyond December 16, 2011.

1 Staff and APS have also discussed the use of technical conferences as part of the discovery
2 phase of this case. Technical conferences may be used as appropriate as a means to narrow the issues
3 on technical matters that are in dispute.

4 While the schedules above may appear aggressive, the signatories (including Staff) to the
5 Settlement Agreement adopted in the last APS rate case agreed to "use good faith efforts to process
6 APS' case(s) within 12 months of a sufficiency finding." This contemplates a Commission Order in
7 June, 2012 with rates effective July 1, 2012.

8 On July 1, 2011, Staff sent an electronic copy of its motion to the other signatories to the
9 Settlement Agreement and to all parties that have filed motions to intervene in the present case. To-
10 date, Staff has heard from SWEEP, Western Resource Advocates ("WRA"), the Town of
11 Wickenburg, the Arizona Investment Council ("AIC"), and SCA Tissue N.A. and they do not object
12 to the proposed schedules.

13 Staff requests that other signatories to the Settlement Agreement and intervenors in this case
14 be prepared to discuss the proposed schedules at the Procedural Conference scheduled for July 18,
15 2011.
