18 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation Commission
19 (“Commission”), Southwest Energy Efficiency Project (“SWEEP”) hereby moves to intervene in
20 the above-captioned docket and, in support thereof, states as follows:

21 1. SWEEP is a non-profit public interest organization promoting greater energy
22 efficiency in six states in the Southwest including Arizona. SWEEP seeks to promote the
23 development of energy efficiency programs, rate design reform, distributed generation resources

1 and other measures that result in the more efficient utilization of electric energy resources.

2 SWEEP has participated in prior Commission proceedings and has staff located in Arizona.

3 2. SWEEP has a substantial interest in this proceeding because APS' proposed rate
4 increase and its proposed treatment of costs associated with the provision of electric energy
5 supplies in this case can significantly influence ratepayer incentives for the efficient use of
6 electricity resources and the overall costs to ratepayers of electric energy services.

7 3. Intervention by SWEEP will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the
8 proceeding.
