16 On April 8, 2011, Qwest Corporation submitted its Compliance Filing in Docket No.
 17 T-01051B-03-0859 (“the QPAP Docket”), amending Exhibit B to the Statement of Generally
 18 Available Terms (the “SGAT”), to comply with Decision No. 72232, in which the Commission
 19 approved the merger of Qwest Communications International, Inc., and CenturyLink, Inc., in
 20 Arizona Corporation Commission Docket No. T-01051B-10-0194 (“the Merger Docket”). In the
 21 Merger Docket, Qwest Corporation committed to change the interface that is available to CLECs
 22 for Interconnection Mediated Access (“IMA”) from the Electronic Data Interchange (“EDI”)

1 interface that has been in use to a new interface known as Extensible Markup Language
2 (“XML”).¹ The filing on April 8, 2011 instituted that change, by revising Exhibit B to the
3 SGAT. Exhibit B contains the Performance Indicator Definitions (“PIDs”) metrics that form part
4 of the Qwest Performance Assurance Plan (“QPAP”). On May 17, 2011 Qwest Corporation
5 filed a notice of errata in the QPAP Docket which included a revised Exhibit K to the SGAT.
6 The changes to Exhibit K are required to update the QPAP to reflect the conversion to the XML
7 interface.

8 These revisions are identical to the changes to the QPAP that have been made in the
9 states of Colorado, Utah, and Montana. The revisions reflect the change from EDI to XML in
10 the gateway availability, and provide for a three month stabilization period described more fully
11 on page 11 therein.

12 In the 3 months since the notice of this change was first made in the QPAP Docket, no
13 party has filed comments or otherwise protested the change.
