QWEST CORPORATION'S FINAL STATUS REPORT REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATION IN OSS ORDER

Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") respectfully submits this final status report ("Final Report") regarding its implementation of the recommendations in the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("the "Commission" or "ACC") Order regarding Qwest's Operational Support Systems ("OSS").<sup>1</sup>

In the OSS Order, the Commission directed Qwest to provide the Commission with quarterly status reports on its progress in implementing the limited and specific OSS recommendations contained in paragraphs 145-151<sup>2</sup> of the Order. Qwest completed all of the



1 implementation activities associated with this requirement during the 2003-2004 timeframe as  
2 first reported in the January 31, 2005 compliance filing for this matter and in subsequent  
3 quarterly reports since then. During the 6 years since Qwest first reported that these OSS  
4 implementation activities had been completed, no party has disputed this fact or raised any issues  
5 with respect to Qwest's compliance with this portion of the OSS Order. Therefore, additional  
6 quarterly reporting of this long since completed activity serves no useful purpose and as such,  
7 this will be the final report in this matter.
