PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 20, 2011, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of Version 12 of Service Schedule 3 and Agreement concerning same.

On July 12, 2011, Local Union 387, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO, CLC ("IBEW Local 387") and Local Union 769, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO, CLC ("IBEW Local 769") filed a Motion to Intervene.

On July 18, 2011, the Arizona Association of Realtors ("AAR") filed a Motion to Intervene.

To date, no objections have been filed and accordingly, IBEW Local 387, IBEW Local 769, and AAR should be granted intervention.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that IBEW Local 387, IBEW Local 769, and AAR are hereby granted intervention.



4 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
5 hearing.

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
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
