

Subject: Pending hike in UNS Gas, Inc. fees

Dear Chairman Pierce:

Regarding the UNS Gas, Inc. pending base rate increase (Docket No. G-04204A-11-0158), I am certain that you are well aware that the cost of everything, including utilities, is constantly increasing. I would, therefore, ask that you very carefully consider the justification for any increase. Please do not follow in the path of the Director of Insurance, who approved an insane 45% increase in my Equitable Long Term Care (LTC) policy, pushing my monthly premium to a point that was unaffordable for my wife and me, after having paid into our plan for more than 10 years. In order to retain some coverage (we are both retired and in our mid-70s), I had to accept reducing our coverage from a 4-year plan to a 3-year plan; plus, still swallow a sizable premium increase. While there may be some justification for increasing gas rates, I sincerely hope that you don't sign any blank checks.
