**PROCEDURAL ORDER**

BY THE COMMISSION:

1 By Procedural Order issued November 23, 2009, "Phase 2" of this proceeding (addressing  
2 LPSCO's proposed hook-up fee tariff) was bifurcated and scheduled to commence following  
3 issuance of the Arizona Corporation Commission's ("Commission") Order setting permanent rates  
4 for LPSCO in Phase 1. (See November 23, 2009 Procedural Order, at 6-8.)

5 On December 10, 2010, the Commission issued Decision No. 72026 in Phase 1 of the above-  
6 captioned consolidated docket. In addition to consideration of the hook-up fee tariff issue in Phase 2,  
7 the Commission directed that the issue of a surcharge mechanism associated with the Phase 1 phase-  
8 in of rates should also be considered in Phase 2. (Decision No. 72026, at 74.)

9 On June 27, 2011, a hearing was held as scheduled on the Phase 2 issues. At the conclusion  
10 of the hearing, interested parties were directed to file briefs by no later than August 5, 2011.

11 On August 3, 2011, LPSCO filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File  
12 Closing Brief. LPSCO requests that the brief filing date be extended to August 9, 2011, and  
13 represented that no party opposes the extension request.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that LPSCO's motion is hereby granted and the Phase 2  
15 closing brief deadline shall be extended to August 9, 2011.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
17 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*  
18 *hac vice*.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance  
20 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
21 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all  
22 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled  
23 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
24 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
26 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the  
27 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,  
2 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at  
3 hearing.
