PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 23, 2011, Livco Water Company ("Livco") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate increase.

On June 10, 2011, Livco filed an Affidavit of Mailing Customer Notice of the rate application.

On June 23, 2011, Livco filed revisions to the rate application.

On June 28, 2011, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed its Letter of Sufficiency indicating that Livco satisfied the requirements of Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-103 for the rate application and classifying the Company as a Class D utility.

On June 28, 2011, Livco filed an application to incur long-term debt.

On July 14, 2011, Livco filed an Affidavit of Publication of Notice of the financing application.

On August 9, 2011, Staff filed a Motion to Consolidate Docket Nos. W-02121A-11-0213 and W-02121A-11-0257. In the Motion, Staff states that the two applications are substantially related and would be most appropriately processed in a consolidated docket.

Good cause is shown and accordingly, Docket Nos. W-02121A-11-0213 and W-02121A-11-0257 should be consolidated for purposes of hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket Nos. W-02121A-11-0213 and W-02121A-11-

1 0257 are hereby consolidated for purposes of hearing.

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
3 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
4 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
6 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
7 hearing.
