PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Notice of Administrative Closure)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 28, 2008, Vernon Valley Water, Inc. ("Vernon Valley" or "Company") filed an application for an extension of its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to provide public water service in various parts of Apache County, Arizona.

On April 28, 2008, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued a Notice of Sufficiency which indicated that the Company's application had met the sufficiency requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-411(C).

On August 6, 2008, the Commission issued Decision No. 70464 which granted an Order Preliminary to the issuance of an extension to the Certificate for Vernon Valley.

Pursuant to Decision No. 70464, the Company was to file multiple compliance items within two years of the effective date of the Decision or the Order Preliminary would be deemed null and void.

On August 18, 2011, Vernon Valley filed a memorandum in the docket requesting an extension of time be granted moving the effective date of compliance to August 6, 2013. Vernon Valley stated that due to economic factors the Company is unable to provide the required compliance items.


On August 26, 2011, the Staff filed a Memorandum which stated that Staff believes that the

1 Company's request for an extension of time would require Commission action pursuant to A.R.S. §
2 40-252. Staff requests that Docket No. W-20540A-08-0178 be administratively closed and that the
3 Order Preliminary be deemed null and void as ordered by Decision No. 70464

4 Accordingly, this docket should be administratively closed and the Order Preliminary
5 authorized by Decision No. 70464 deemed null and void.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Docket No. W-20540A-08-0178** is hereby
7 **administratively closed and the Order Preliminary authorized by Decision No. 70464** is hereby
8 **deemed null and void.**


