On December 20, 2010, Mosaic Networx, LLC ("Mosaic" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide facilities-based local exchange and resold and facilities-based intraLATA and interLATA private line telecommunication services throughout Arizona. Mosaic's application also requests a determination that its proposed services are competitive.

On May 31, 2011, Staff filed a Staff Report recommending approval of Mosaic's application subject to certain conditions.

On July 15, 2011, by Procedural Order, a hearing was set to commence on September 12, 2011.

On August 24, 2011, Mosaic filed a notice of appearance and request for Mosaic's witness to appear telephonically for the hearing scheduled for September 12, 2011.

Mosaic's request for its witness to appear telephonically for the hearing scheduled for September 12, 2011, is reasonable and should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Mosaic's request for its witness to appear telephonically for the hearing scheduled for September 12, 2011, is hereby granted.


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Mosaic shall contact the Hearing Division two days**

10 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
11 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
13 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
