PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

By Procedural Order dated August 11, 2011, the hearing in this matter was set to continue on September 12 and 13, 2011. Subsequently, Goodman Water Co. ("GWC" or the "Company") and the intervenors<sup>1</sup> entered into settlement discussions which lead to a settlement between and among those parties. All parties participated in a telephonic procedural conference on September 8, 2011, at which time they indicated that the settlement would be presented to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Utilities Division ("Staff") later that afternoon. All parties agreed that the September 12 and 13, 2011, hearing dates should be vacated in light of these recent developments. In addition, the parties discussed scheduling a new hearing date, but various factors prevented setting a new hearing date.

It is important for a thorough record that all parties appear at the subsequent hearing, and the parties agreed to discuss possible hearing dates and present a proposal for the consideration the Administrative Law Judge in a subsequent procedural conference.


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the September 12 and 13, 2011 hearing dates are hereby vacated, and the hearing will be rescheduled to recommence at a date to be determined.**

5 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


