PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Procedural Order dated September 8, 2011, at the request of the parties, the September 12 and 13, 2011, hearing dates for this rate case were vacated after some of the parties entered into a settlement agreement and additional time was needed to prepare testimony concerning that agreement.

In a telephonic procedural conference on September 13, 2011, in which all parties participated, a new procedural schedule was proposed. All parties agreed to the following schedule:

File Settlement Agreement	September 15, 2011
Testimony in support of the Settlement	October 4, 2011
Testimony in opposition to the Settlement	October 24, 2011
Hearing	October 31 & November 1, 2011

At this time, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") Utilities Division ("Staff") was the only party not a party to the Settlement Agreement. Although the focus of the continued hearing will shift to the proposed settlement, all parties agreed that at the forthcoming hearing any party will be permitted to cross examine witnesses on pre-settlement testimony as well as settlement testimony. It was also agreed that another Procedural Conference after Staff has filed its

1 testimony on the settlement, to discuss availability of witnesses, would be beneficial in order to  
2 ensure that all parties have an opportunity to create a thorough record.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** in this matter shall continue on **October 31,**  
4 **2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's Tucson Office, **Room**  
5 **222, 400 W. Congress St., Tucson, AZ 85701. The hearing will continue on November 1 and 2,**  
6 **2011, commencing at 9:30 a.m., if additional days are needed.**

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that given the apparent changes in the positions of some of the  
8 parties, there will be an opportunity for additional public comment at the beginning of the hearing on  
9 October 31, 2011.<sup>1</sup>

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **telephonic Procedural Conference** for the purpose of  
11 scheduling witnesses and discussing any other matters affecting the conduct of the hearing, shall  
12 commence on **October 25, 2011, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, **Room 218, 400**  
13 **West Congress, Tucson, Arizona.** The conference call is graciously being arranged by the Residential  
14 Utility Consumer Office and the call-in number and code are the same as for the September 13, 2011,  
15 Procedural Conference.<sup>2</sup>

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties to the **Settlement Agreement** shall docket a  
17 **copy of the Settlement Agreement by September 15, 2011.**

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **testimony and exhibits in support of the Settlement**  
19 **Agreement** shall be filed on or before **October 4, 2011.**<sup>3</sup>

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **testimony and exhibits in opposition to the Settlement**  
21 **Agreement** shall be docketed on or before **October 24, 2011.**



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
