PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 3, 2010, Michael W. Schultz and Pamela J. Schultz d/b/a Rincon Creek Water Comany ("Rincon Creek"), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval to sell its water system assets and transfer its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to William Shirley and Gretchen Shirley ("Transferees" and, together with Rincon Creek, the "Applicants").

On December 11, 2010, a hearing was held on the application.

On August 15, 2011, a Procedural Order was issued directing the Applicants and Staff to file Opening Briefs addressing certain issues no later than September 16, 2011, and to file Reply Briefs no later than October 7, 2011.

On September 9, 2011, Lawrence V. Robertson, Jr., filed a Notice of Retention and Entry of Appearance, stating that he had been retained by the Applicants to represent them in connection with this matter.

On September 9, 2011, Applicants filed a Motion for Extension of Briefing Dates ("Motion"), requesting that filing deadlines be extended due to previous commitments of Applicants' counsel. The Applicants requested that the date for filing Opening Briefs be extended from September 16, 2011, to October 31, 2011, and that the due date for Reply Briefs be extended to November 21, 2011. Staff did not oppose the proposed extensions.

Applicants' Motion is reasonable and shall be granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **Applicants and Staff shall file their Reply Briefs no later than November 21, 2011.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, after review of the parties' respective briefs, the Administrative Law Judge reserves the right to set the matter for oral argument, if deemed necessary.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


