Within the Ordering paragraphs, page 10, line 3, the Order inadvertently states that the Company will provide resold *long distance* telecommunications services, however, the Company applied to provide resold *local* telecommunications services. Broadview already holds a CC&N in Arizona for the provision of resold *long distance* telecommunication services pursuant to Decision No. 71295. By this Motion, Staff requests that a Procedural Order be issued correcting the typographical error on page 10, line 3, by deleting *long distance* and inserting *local, nunc pro tunc*.


