PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Extends Filing Dates)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 17, 2011, Cedar Grove Water, Inc. ("Company" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an increase in its permanent rates and charges.

On May 20, 2011, the Company filed a letter stating that although the Company had requested revenues in excess of \$250,000, which will result in the Applicant being classified as a Class C water utility, the Company is requesting that its application be processed on the short form rate application which the Company used in its filing that is normally utilized in rate applications by Class D and Class E water utilities.

On June 16, 2011, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-103, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a letter indicating the Company's rate application was sufficient, and classifying the Company as a Class C utility.

On June 22, 2011, by Procedural Order, certain dates were established for the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

On October 3, 2011, Staff filed a request for a seven day extension of time, until October 14, 2011, to file a Staff Report and/or Direct Testimony instead of October 7, 2011, due to personnel changes.

Accordingly, Staff's request should be granted, and the Company should have a similar period of time to file rebuttal testimony, if needed.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **Staff Report and/or any direct testimony and**
2 **associated exhibits** to be presented at hearing on behalf of Staff shall be reduced to writing and
3 filed on or before **October 14, 2011**, as requested by Staff.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **rebuttal testimony and associated exhibits** to be
5 presented at hearing by the Company shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **October 28, 2011**.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **surrebuttal testimony and associated exhibits** to be
7 presented by the Staff and/or intervenors shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **November**
8 **4, 2011**.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **rejoinder testimony and associated exhibits to be**
10 **presented at the hearing shall be presented orally at the hearing**.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
12 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
13 *pro hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
15 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
16 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
17 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
18 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
19 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
21 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
22 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended
24 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (e) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend, or
2 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
3 hearing.


