17 Pursuant to the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Arizona Corporation
18 Commission ("Commission"), the Arizona School Boards Association ("ASBA") and the
19 Arizona Association of School Business Officials ("AASBO") (collectively),
20 (ASBA/AASBO") hereby petition for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket
21 and, in support thereof, state as follows:
22

23 1. ASBA is a non-partisan, non-profit organization governed by its members.

24 More than 240 public school governing boards are members of the Arizona
25

1 School Boards Association. Its members represent more than 1,200 school board
2 members and over 1.12 million Arizona children. ASBA members have a vital interest in
3 energy issues and costs. Arizona's public schools are significant consumers of electric
4 energy and energy services and will be significantly affected by the Commission's
5 decision in this proceeding.

6 2. AASBO is a non-profit professional association providing support and
7 professional development opportunities for individuals whose primary responsibility is
8 the business management of a school district. Among its functions is to promote
9 effectiveness and efficiency in school business methods and practices including the
10 procurement of Arizona's public schools energy needs.

11 3. Intervention by ASBA/AASBO will not unduly broaden the issues or delay
12 the proceeding. ASBA/AASBO do not yet know what position they will take in this
13 proceeding.


