35 hereby petitions for leave to intervene in the above-captioned docket and, in support

37 **Interwest Energy Alliance**

38 1. Interwest ("Interwest") is a 510(c)(6) trade association comprised of a mix of
39 industry and non-governmental advocacy groups, which collectively seek to encourage

1 renewable project and transmission development throughout the West. Interwest
2 represents the interests of non-governmental organizations and renewable energy
3 developers and primarily wind and solar product manufacturers. See:

5 Interwest seeks through education and advocacy to create state-level policies
6 supporting renewable energy development, and to encourage consensus-based
7 approaches to new project and transmission development throughout the West. The

10 2. Interwest and its members have a substantial interest in this proceeding. The
11 Commission's decision may affect the extent, timing and source of Arizona Public

15 this docket. Intervention by SI will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.


