Low Income Relief Tariff Calculation for 2012

Applicable to:

- Global Water – Santa Cruz Water Company
- Global Water – Palo Verde Utilities Company
- Valencia Water Company, Inc.
- Water Utility of Greater Buckeye, Inc.
- Water Utility of Greater Tonopah, Inc.
- Willow Valley Water Company, Inc.

Purpose:

The purpose of this tariff is to define the process for funding Low Income Relief Program (LIRP). Funding for the LIRP includes a customer surcharge and a Company match. Company is owned by Global Water Resources (Global).

Funding:

Funding for the Global Water LIRP is provided by a combination of:

1. Consumer Surcharge:

$$\frac{\$ 50,000/\text{yr} \div 12 \text{ mo/yr}}{39,556 \text{ Active Connections}^1} = \$0.11 \text{ per month, per connection}$$

The Consumer Surcharge will be added to each monthly invoice for all consumers. In the case of Palo Verde and Santa Cruz, a single surcharge of \$0.22 on the consolidated invoice will be added.

2. Global Water Match: \$ 4,167.00/month

The Global Water Match will be provided to the Arizona Community Action Association on a monthly basis.

Details of the program are available in GWR-CP-EX-043, effective date 1 January 2011.
