

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING  
FOR AMENDMENT OF  
ADMINISTRATIVE RULES**

On September 15, 1998, the Arizona Corporation Commission initiated a rulemaking process to amend certain Arizona Administrative Rules concerning public service corporations. The purpose of this rulemaking is to implement time frames for the processing of applications for Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") and applications to amend or change the status of any existing CCN. The amendments implement requirements identified in Arizona Revised Statutes §§41-1072 through 1078.

The Commission will hold a public comment hearing in this matter on November 10, 1998 at 1:00 p.m. at the Commission's Hearing Room, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ. Although comments will be taken through November 10, 1998, initial written comments are requested to be filed by October 16, 1998 and written reply comments by November 6, 1998. Any written comments may be sent to Ray J. Williamson, Acting Director, Utilities Division, 1200 W. Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
