PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 1, 2011, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to determine the fair value of the utility property of the Company for ratemaking purposes, to fix a just and reasonable rate of return thereon, and to approve rate schedules designed to develop such return.

On November 8, 2011, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Motion to File Direct Testimony of Laura Furrey ("Motion") on December 2, 2011. According to the Motion, Ms. Furrey's testimony will address several issues related to APS' renewable and energy efficiency adjustor mechanisms, and that due to Ms. Furrey's workload in other cases, an extension of time for her to file her testimony in this matter was necessary. No party objected to the Motion.

Good cause is shown and accordingly, Staff's Motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff's Motion is granted and Staff shall file Ms. Furrey's testimony on or before December 2, 2011.
