We met with Gary Watson (County Supervisor) & Jack Kramer (Kingman City Manager) about the use of Kingmans' E-fluent water last week. We were hoping the city would offer to share, split or somehow help out with the cost of the 10 mile & 2 -3 pump requirements to deliver the water. Well no such luck. This estimate is around \$2 million. The part that Gary either didn't know or just left out in our earlier meeting is the requirement for a day or two day storage tank with a 250 horsepower pump. The tank & pump, which would belong to Kingman & be on their property, would add another (about) \$1 million. Since our CC & Rs don't let us mortgage & we are not allowed to put anything up for collateral & we are a not for profit community we can't pursue this any farther.

Our last hope now & a couple of us are looking, is for a single person or small group to put up a million or more to persue the well idea & we just make payments to them instead of the Neils. This is for irrigation only. Our test well we collected donations for was 1200 feet & doesn't produce enough to water the greens for 9 holes. So we have to look in another location to drill. We are pretty much up a creek without a paddle.

Know any investors with 1 - 2 million dollars to make a little interest on?
