BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 13, 2011, Qwest Corporation d/b/a CenturyLink-QC ("CenturyLink") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application to classify and regulate retail local exchange telecommunications services as competitive, and to classify and deregulate certain services as non-essential.

On November 22, 2011, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") filed a Motion to Intervene ("Motion").

To date, no objections have been filed, and accordingly, RUCO should be granted intervention.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that RUCO is hereby granted intervention.
