PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 8, 2011, Pima Utility Company ("Pima") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") in the above-captioned dockets applications for authority to: (1) issue evidence of indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$8,370,000 in connection with (a) infrastructure improvements to the utility system and (b) the purchase of equity; and (2) encumber real property and plant as security for such indebtedness for its water and wastewater systems.

On November 16, 2011, Pima filed a Motion to Consolidate Docket Nos. W-02199A-11-0403 and SW-02199A-11-0404 ("Motion"). In its Motion, Pima states that its water and wastewater customer bases are largely the same and Pima is operated and managed as one utility.

No objection has been filed.

Good cause has been shown and accordingly, the cases should be consolidated.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket Nos. W-02199A-11-0403 and SW-02199A-11-
2 0404 are hereby consolidated for purposes of hearing.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
4 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
5 hearing.


