Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In Decision No. 60198 (May 16, 1997), the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") granted Golden Tel, Inc. ("GTI" or "Company"), a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in Arizona.

2. On July 29, 2011, GTI filed an application with the Commission requesting to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona.

3. On August 9, 2011, Kimberly K. Ross, a representative for the Company, filed an amended application stating she was authorized to file the application to cancel the CC&N; GTI no longer provides or never provided service in Arizona; and that the Company waives its right to a hearing on the cancellation of its CC&N.

4. On September 16, 2011, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Memorandum in response to GTI's application recommending that the Commission approve the

1 application for cancellation.

2 5. The Commission's Compliance Section indicates that there are no compliance issues
3 related to the Company. The Commission's Consumer Services Section also reported that there have
4 been no complaints or opinions filed against GTI.

5 6. The Corporations Division reports no record was found for Golden Tel, Inc., and that
6 the Company is not incorporated in Arizona.

7 7. Staff's recommendation for approval of GTI's application to cancel its CC&N is
8 reasonable and should be adopted.

9 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

10 1. GTI is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona
11 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

12 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over GTI and the subject matter of the application.

13 3. The cancellation of GTI's CC&N to provide customer-owned pay telephone services
14 in Arizona is in the public interest.

15 4. GTI waived its right to notice and a hearing in this matter.

16 5. Staff's recommendation for approval of GTI's application is reasonable and should be
17 adopted.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Golden Tel, Inc. to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (granted in Decision No. 60198) to provide customer-owned pay telephone service in Arizona, is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.


