Page 9, line 22:

**INSERT** New Finding of Fact, Paragraph 34:

"The Commission finds that it's in the best interests of ratepayers and Tucson Electric Power to continue to fund the Solar Test Yard, which is providing real value to research and development of solar technology in Arizona. Thus, we find it reasonable to restore Solar Test Yard funding to \$350,000 rather than reduce it to \$275,000. Arizona gets a very high benefit for low cost from the Solar Test Yard as it contributes to local knowledge, innovation and our local university."

Page 9, line 22:

**INSERT** New Finding of Fact, Paragraph 35:

"The Commission finds that it's in the best interests of ratepayers to reduce EPRI's Distribution Integration Study budget by \$75,000, thus changing the amount from \$191,000 to \$116,000. There are many other institutions such as the National Renewable Energy Lab doing this type of research, and although EPRI's study would be useful, it's of far more benefit to Arizonans to spend money on local projects, local knowledge, and our local university through the Solar Test Yard."

Page 37, line 27.5:

**INSERT** New Ordering Paragraph:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tucson Electric Power will fund the Solar Test Yard in the amount of \$350,000 rather than \$275,000; and reduce funding for EPRI's Distribution Integration Study by the same amount (\$75,000), so that EPRI's total funding for the Distribution Integration Study will be \$116,000 for 2012."
