
On December 6, 2011, MCImetro Access Transmission Services LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services ("Verizon Access") filed tariff revisions reflecting implementation of the intercarrier compensation regime for certain VoIP-PSTN traffic that was mandated (absent agreement by the affected companies) by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") in its November 18, 2011 Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in WC Dockets No. 10-90, etc. ("Order"). Verizon Access requested a tariff effective date of January 1, 2012, in accordance with the FCC Order.

To accommodate the Commission's Open Meeting schedule, however, Verizon Access agrees to waive the 30-day time period in which Verizon Access' tariff revisions would be deemed approved absent Commission action.

Verizon Access, however, requests approval of its tariff revisions as soon as possible; Verizon Access must, in any event, comply with the FCC's VoIP-PSTN compensation regime.
