In Decision No. 72031, dated December 10, 2010, the Commission ordered that:

"APS, SWTC and TEP shall conduct additional analysis of potential 230kV and 138kV voltage deviations in Southeastern Arizona as noted in the 2009 SATS report and file an update based on the 2010 SATS by February 28, 2011, and shall finalize mitigation plans if needed for this voltage concern in ten-year plan filing(s) for the 7th BTA by January 31, 2012."

Although Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") does not have any 230 kV or 138 kV transmission lines in Southeastern Arizona, APS is a member of the WestConnect Planning areas and the Southwest Area Transmission (SWAT) Sub-Regional Planning Group. APS also participates in various SWAT subcommittees, including the Southeast Arizona Transmission System (SATS) subcommittee.

SWTC, on behalf of APS and TEP, conducted the analysis of voltage deviations, as reported in SWTC's 2012-2021 Ten Year Plan. In summary, SWTC is proposing to add capacitor banks to their system and various line upgrades, which if taken together, will resolve the delta-V issues as seen in the 2010 SATS report.
