

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF HYPERCUBE TELECOM, LLC FOR APPROVAL OF A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE RESOLD AND FACILITIES-BASED LOCAL EXCHANGE AND LONG DISTANCE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN ARIZONA (DOCKET NO. T-20805A-11-0221)

On May 31, 2011, Hypercube Telecom, LLC ("Hypercube") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold and facilities-based local exchange and long distance telecommunications services in Arizona ("Application"). Hypercube's Application also requests a determination that its proposed services are competitive in Arizona. The Commission will issue a Decision following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by Hypercube, Staff, or any intervenors. Hypercube will be required to provide service under the rates, charges, terms and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of the Application, Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report filed by Hypercube or intervenor(s) will be available at Hypercube's offices, 3200 West Pleasant Run Road, Suite 300, Lancaster, TX 75146, at the Commission's Docket Control Center at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ; and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function. The Commission will hold a hearing on Hypercube's application on March 8, 2012, at 10:00AM, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 2, Phoenix, AZ. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via e-mail (for instructions go to http://www.azcc.gov/Division/Utilities/forms/PublicCommentForm.pdf) or by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-20805A-11-0221 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to Hypercube or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following: 1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor; 2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of Hypercube, a shareholder of Hypercube, etc.); 3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to Hypercube or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case; and 4. If you are not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and are not representing yourself as an individual, a statement with information and any appropriate documentation, demonstrating compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.R.C. 114-3-116, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before February 24, 2012. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on the person's own behalf. If representation by counsel is required by Arizona Supreme Court Rules, intervention will be conditions upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
