

Dear Commissioners:

My concerns involve the health, safety and welfare of the residents and users of water being supplied by the Truxton Canyon Water Company. As I understand it, the water has high arsenic levels and the water being supplied by Truxton Canyon Water Company to the homes in Valle Vista is not potable.

I know that the problem is basically an ADEQ problem, but they say ADEQ has failed to get the problems solved in over five years. I understand the contamination has escalated to the extent that the water contains three times the acceptable levels of arsenic. More tests need to be ordered to find out what other contaminants are in that water. The residents deserve a letter to every home advising them not to drink, bathe in or cook with their tap water until the problems are solved. The State should be advised that every home has received such a letter.


As I review previous documents in the ACC files, I read that this company has financial problems, but people's lives seem to be at stake here. Something must be done to protect these people.
